



CSP Delivery Models 2011/2012

We've put together this CSP Delivery Models document to help potential partners in the delivery of Sportivate (especially NGBs) engage with the delivery chain of CSPs across the country. The CSPs are arranged alphabetically by region (i.e. East, East Midlands, etc).

Sportivate will be measured by 4 KPIs:

KPI Participants – The number of participants registering and taking part in at least one session of a minimum of 6 and a maximum of 8 weekly coaching sessions of sports activity (participants engaged).

KPI Throughput – Attendance: the cumulative total number of participants taking part at the series of weekly coaching sessions.

KPI Retain – The number of participants who attend 5 of 6, 6 of 7 or 7 of 8 weekly coaching sessions (participants retained).

KPI Sustain – The number of participants who indicated that after taking part in Sportivate weekly coaching sessions they continued to participate regularly in activity (in their own time) for at least the next 3 months in either: a) informal settings (such as casual or pay-and-play opportunities) or b) via more formal opportunities such as becoming members of facilities/clubs/leagues (participants sustained).

All CSPs will require the following information as part of any Sportivate project application:

Evidence of Demand:

Sportivate is principally a demand-led programme. Applicants will be expected to show that there is demand for the project they are planning and from where participants are being sourced but there is the opportunity to build capacity in certain sports where a strategic need has been identified.

High Quality Exit Route:

All projects must be designed with a community exit route such as a club or less formal opportunity for continued participation in the chosen sport. The exit route should be suitable for the target group, immediately identified and there should be an owner (i.e. coach or volunteer) of the link to the exit route.

Other Notes:

Participant charges: Providers may be encouraged to include income from participants to be fed into the sustainability of the project or used against the project's expenditure. Some CSPs may insist upon this.

Partnership funding: Providers may be encouraged to include income from partnership funding to be used against the project's expenditure. Some CSPs may insist upon this. Please bear in mind that Sportivate is lottery funded and therefore all projects must demonstrate additionality to Whole Sport Plans and Whole Sport Plan funding.

Please note that CSPs have the mandate to accept or reject any proposed projects though Sport England will have ultimate sign off of all projects. Each CSP has the flexibility to deliver Sportivate in a way that is appropriate to the local area and they will all have different processes, priorities and principles. This is intentional and will be a key factor in the success of Sportivate but the majority of CSPs will offer a route for potential partners to submit projects covering more than one local authority area even if funding is primarily distributed through the local authority network.

Sportivate's part of the London 2012 Mass Participation Legacy and so 'it will bring the inspiration and magic of a home Olympics and Paralympics into the heart of local communities, encouraging more people to get involved in sport'.

Delivery Funding Model:

Allocated Model

Details:

The 10 Local Authorities/CSNs have had £9k of funding earmarked for their area and each of the 4 further education colleges will receive £5k of funding.

Timescales:

Pilots to start in April with full roll out in July.

The annual plans from our delivery partners will have to be submitted to us by the 3rd May – we will then assess these on a whole as a county offer before submitting our annual plan to SE on the 16th May. Some projects are due to start in April but it is not until May/June that the program will really start to be delivered across the county – again it is difficult to calculate the number of projects at this time as we are still in the planning stage.

How can partners get involved?

Partners will be asked to submit plans to local SDO/CSNs. We will then meet with the SDO/CSNs as a steering group to determine where the funding will be allocated – HSP will have the final say on whether a project is funded.

Partner planning days

Networking day - we held a networking day on the 25th March. Approx 25 NGB's were able to attend, all LA SDOs, 4 FESCOs and other college staff and a few other delivery partners like Lee Valley Regional Park Authority

Application and Payment Process:

Planning: Some LA/CSNs have created a modified word document for clubs etc. to submit the details of their projects on. If approved these will then be transferred to the Sportivate planning sheet.

Payment mechanism: We are still to determine what is the best method for us and our delivery partners – although it looks likely to be a split payment: 50% upfront and 50% upon receipt of the first 6 months KPIs

Target Groups:

It is difficult at this stage of planning to say what the breakdowns will be. However, each LA/CSN is aware that they have to deliver projects that reflect their local population. It is expected that we will have a roughly even split of male/female and a broad range of age groups.

Details: LIVING SPORT will be the only organisation that will accept Sportivate applications. We have not targeted specific organisations at this early stage of the programme. LIVING SPORT is looking to have a wide range of supported organisations within its portfolio. As the project develops and there are certain organisations or groups that we feel will need to engage with more LIVNG SPORT will work closer with these identified groups.

LIVING SPORT will look to all get an even spread of projects

How can partners get involved?

Partner planning days: There are four partner planning workshops being delivered in Cambridgeshire & Peterborough. All of which are taking place at the CSP's office due to its central location within the county. They are taking place on the following dates and time:

Timescales: Annual Plan with April (21st) deadline for submissions for Qs 2, 3 & 4. Pilot projects running in Q1. Second application deadline, September 1st. Partners will be able to submit applications for Qrt 3-4 deliver.

Additional Planning Days will take place at the end of July or beginning of August in preparation for the 1st of September application deadline. Exact dates and times are tbc.

Other Details: LIVING SPORT are also looking to develop the work our NGB lead has done with NGBs and the development of core spec agreements between NGBs & CSPs.

Application and Payment Process:

Planning: LIVING SPORT are delivering planning days for partners across year 1 of the programme and also for the start of year 2. LVING SPORT will also look to support application writing and project planning to improve quality of applications and improve partnership working.

Payment mechanism:

LIVING SPORT will distribute the total amount of funding awarded in 2 installments. 70% of the grant awarded will be distributed before the first session (as long as the SLA has been signed) and then the final 30% will be distributed once the KPI and relevant documents have been completed and returned.

Target Groups:

At LIVING SPORT we are planning to get and even spread across the age range of 14-25 and also gender. The CSP will look to monitor this over the course of the project and if there is a situation that occurs that we are engaging with a gender or age range to much then we will look to address this with the organisations we are engaging with and the application we are supporting.

We will use an open application model.

Details: Initially we will utilize the existing network of effective deliverers from sport unlimited whilst new delivery partnerships are explored. We are exploring county-wide strategies with NGBs and localized delivery through the Active Alliance Network. Other strategic partners will be explored as the local sports development environment becomes clearer.

Timescales: Pilot projects to be run in April through to June. Full roll-out will begin from July 2011. thereafter, sixmonthly Delivery Plans, but possibly using two application periods within each six months.

How can partners get involved?

Partner planning days:

We are currently planning a county network event to promote engagement with all new and existing projects.

NGB briefings will be carried-out at quarterly NGB forums (due on 27 April, 19 July, 25 October), plus we are arranging 1-2-1 meetings to discuss county-wide delivery models with those NGBs willing and able to deliver. A number of these meetings have already taken place.

Sportivate will be promoted through active alliance meetings, local sports network meetings the SDO forum, PDM forum, plus through meetings with HE and FE sports

Application and Payment Process:

Planning:

Applications will initially be accepted direct from deliverers using the Sportivate Delivery Plan spreadsheets plus an additional information gathering document. Where county strategic partners are in place (i.e. NGBs etc) we will coordinate assessment and acceptance of applications with them.

Our payment method will be through an Essex County Council grant system called GC30. This negates the otherwise necessary process of creating' preferred suppliers'.

Payment mechanism:

50% up front with remainder dependant on the level of successful retention (as agreed with the deliverer).

Target Groups:

We will utilise local population data to initially apportion funding to local authority areas. Existing partners from sport unlimited will provide access to the lower age ranges. We will build new partnerships towards engaging the higher age range target groups.



All of the above are effective ways in which partners can be involved in the programme. We are very aware of promoting this project to as many different groups in the county as possible, to ensure that we are targeting the right users and each district has a fair share of the funding we receive.

Application and Payment Process:

Planning:

Lots of partners had expressed their interest soon after the announcement of Sportivate went public.

We made a note of these projects and sent out some more information that we had devised for the programme. We have put together our own application form taking parts from the Sport Unlimited form and the planning delivery template for those who would like to complete a hard copy application.

Our main application will be to use the Sportivate plan provided by SE which will be available to download from our webpage on 1st April 2011.

Payment mechanism: (70% paid at the start of the programme and the remaining 30% on completion of receiving the sustainability data.)

Target Groups:

We will be looking in particular at projects that target minority groups, such as disability sport and projects aimed at targeting young women/girls.

We have a good relationship with the HE/FE sector in the County and we will be working on encouraging the 16+ "drop off" age to take part in Sportivate, this being achieved through working with this sector.

As previously mentioned we will be holding an open application model, however, we will prioritise projects that aim to target those "hard to reach" groups in more isolated parts of the county.
